


## 3.1 PRE-QUALIFICATION

3.1.1 To advance designated groups on the basis of Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) Status Level of contributor, bidders will be prequalified on the basis of their B-BBEE Status of Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 contributor. Bidders must submit a valid B-BBEE certificate or sworn affidavit (the sworn affidavit must indicate the full date of the financial yearend i.e.: day, month and year e.g., 31 March 2021

## 3.2 MANDATORY EVALUATION CRITERIA.

3.2.1 Fidelity fund certificate for the law firm













# **PART 4: FUNCTIONALITY EVALUATION**

- 4.1. The section below constitutes the functional evaluation for all **Law Firms** that wish to be included in the database of specialized suppliers.
  - a. The information required here is the area of legal competency that your Law Firm specializes in, and years of the existence of the company whilst doing its chosen competency (10 points).
  - b. Provide examples of projects previously undertaken by your Law Firm or project leaders in their individual capacity for the following litigious and labour matters in the:
    - Magistrate Court,
    - Labour Court,
    - High Court,
    - Supreme Court and / or
    - Constitutional /advice provided by your law firm.

Be able to provide proof of expertise and provide proof of contactable references (40 points).

c. Skills of the **project lead, i.e.,** number of cases successfully handled and projects (Applicants are required to submit copies of the CVs of their responsible project leader who will be driving their chosen field of competency / expertise as chosen in 4.2 below) (**30 points**).

Each key project leader proposed per competency / expertise will be scored individually on the full points of 30 and averaged.

 d. Applicants are also required to submit certified copies of the qualifications of the lead project member selected and proof of registration with a professional body (20 points)

A company must at least achieve <u>70 points</u> of functionality to be included in the panel.

- 4.2.1 Bidders should tick all the applicable field(s) of competency or expertise. The Legal Services Panel of Experts will be made up of sub-panels according to field of expertise above.
- 4.2.2 Request for quotations (RFQs) and Request for proposals (RFPs) will be issued within the panel according to the legal services required.

#### 4.3. **COMPANY EXPERIENCE (10 POINTS)**

Applicants must provide a Company profile. The score for the company years of relevant experience is calculated alongside the submitted company profile, company registration and the CSD report as follows:

YEARS OF EXPERIENCE	POINTS ALLOCATED
LESS THAN 1 YEAR	0 points
FROM 1 YEAR TO 4 YEARS	2 points
ABOVE 4 TO 6 YEARS	4 points
ABOVE 6 TO 10 YEARS	6 points
ABOVE 10 TO 15 YEARS	8 points
ABOVE 15 YEARS	10 points















# 4.4. NUMBER OF PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN (40 POINTS)

Applicants (Law Firm or project leaders in their individual capacity) are required to provide a list of legal services related contracts / projects undertaken, as referred to section 4.2 above. The list of projects <u>MUST</u> be supported by relevant and valid reference letters. The reference letters must be contactable. RSR reserves the right to contact the references provided to verify validity. The score for the evaluation of this section is structured as follows:

#### NB:

- 4.4.1 Applicants **MUST** submit signed reference letters from clients.
- 4.4.2 One reference letter per project, per competency / expertise as chosen in 4.2 above.
- 4.4.3 The reference letter should be on a client's official letterhead with valid contact details, scope of the work and standard of service.
- 4.4.4 Failure to submit contactable reference letters on a client letterhead to support the list provided will lead to no points being scored for that specific project.
- 4.4.5 The letters should not be older than five (05) years.

Reference letters will be evaluated per project, per competency / expertise as chosen in 4.2 above.





# 4.5. SKILLS (30)

Applicants are required to submit copies of the CV of **their responsible project leader/s** who will be managing their chosen field of competency / expertise as chosen in 4.2 above. The chosen project leader/s will be evaluated as follows:

Scoring: Each key project leader proposed per competency / expertise will be scored individually on the full points of 30 as detailed above and averaged.

# 4.6. QUALIFICATION AND REGISTRATION (20)

Applicants are required to submit copies of the qualifications of the lead project member selected. The evaluation of qualifications and registration will be as follows;


#### 5 **DETERMING COSTS**
